The Three Choirs Festival is committed to diversity, equality and inclusion, and to welcoming audience members and performers from all walks of life. We undertake to make reasonable adjustments to increase accessibility to the Three Choirs Festival and to ensure we can meet the needs of the broadest range of audience members possible.

In order to meet this objective, if you have any access requirements, we encourage you to make us aware of them at the time of your booking. We ask that you declare any medical conditions, disability or reduced mobility that would inhibit you from attending the festival without additional support as this helps us to provide advice on whether you are likely to encounter any difficulties during your visit. A number of our audience members attend alongside their own caregivers to enable their attendance. The festival is unable to provide specialist caregiving support.

In the vast majority of cases, accessibility arrangements will have already been made to ensure you can enjoy and access the festival. In a small number of circumstances, it may not be possible for us to make the additional arrangements we consider necessary.

In purchasing tickets for our events, attendees vouchsafe that they have the adequate support in place to ensure their personal safety and wellbeing for the duration of their visit. In the interests of safety, we reserve the right to refuse entrance to audience members where we deem such provision is not in place.
